



Army e-Learning has become the Army's primary means of satisfying initial and recurring information technology (IT) training across the entire spectrum of individual and organizational requirements. The Army e-Learning program offers over 2,600 IT, business, Rosetta Stone® foreign language, leadership, and interpersonal skills courses to all active duty Army, National Guard, Reserves, and DA civilians. Courses are free to the individuals and their organizations. To date over 430,000 students have enrolled!
