Dear Commander:

I have prepared the following contingency information.

The documentation provided will assist in compliance with the Oil Pollution Act of 1990 (OPA '90), specifically 33 CFR Part 154 - Coast Guard Facility Response Plan requirements, 40 CFR Part 112- EPA Facility Response Plan requirements, EPA SPCC Plan requirements and 49 CFR Part 194 - RSPA on Shore oil pipelines, and the Oil Discharge Contingency Plan (ODCP) for the State of Virginia. The criteria for response resources and response time frames should not be interpreted to be performance standards because they are based on a set of assumptions that may not exist during an actual oil spill incident. Therefore, it should be understood that the resources and response times listed below are provided to assist the facility owner and operator to help plan to respond to an oil spill. Enclosed you will find a copy of our "Oil Spill Response Organization (OSRO)" classification from the Coast Guard.

Industrial Marine Service, Inc. (IMS) is an oil spill response contractor which provides the services listed in Attachment A. IMS can respond to Group I through Group V oils and non-petroleum oils. We have the following Hazwoper trained response personnel who can be made available for response to spills:

IMS can provide Hazwoper training and outfitting for hundreds of "surge" laborers should that be required.

Attachment B is the current listing of equipment to which we have access for spill response activities.

The cited personnel, equipment and services are capable of being provided at or above the tier cap level of response within stipulated response times in specific geographical areas as follows:

Shorter response times or other geographical areas may be contracted for on a continuous or case-by-case basis. IMS can be available for one hour response to your facility by short term or long term contracts placing personnel and equipment on "dedicated standby" at your facility, or in proximity to the transfer site.


IMS intends to commit these resources in the event of a spill and will offer its best efforts to do so under the circumstances then existing, including emergency response activities being provided to other clients. IMS will permit the U.S. Coast Guard to verify the availability of the response resources identified through tests, inspections and drills. Currently, there will be no fee for listing IMS as a response organization in your plan. Determination of fee rates will be based on the number of subscribing companies and the additional equipment which we may need to purchase. Those factors should be known to us at a later date, at which time they will be incorporated into a negotiated agreement and fee schedule, and offered for you to accept or decline.

IMS has recently opened a full service office in Baltimore, MD. This office will provide USCG level A-E OSRO coverage in the Baltimore COTP zone. The coast guard has updated their records to reflect our level of resources we maintain in the Baltimore COTP.

To be effective, this document must be acknowledge by the company using it, and a copy showing that acknowledgment must be received by IMS before it is effective. This document, with its attachments, must be incorporated by reference into the oil spill response plan(s) which rely on any of the listed IMS resources.


